



Sunday 26 May saw a spectacular encounter between Shilo and a pod of about 9 dolphins 1 km north of the St Kilda channel in the Barker Inlet. Glassy water made these terrific pictures possible (thanks to Jo and Sarah Hill). In the photo on the front page the dolphin nearest the top is "Big Fold"; he has a damaged dorsal fin and has been known to dolphin expert Mike Bossley for 20 years. years.
