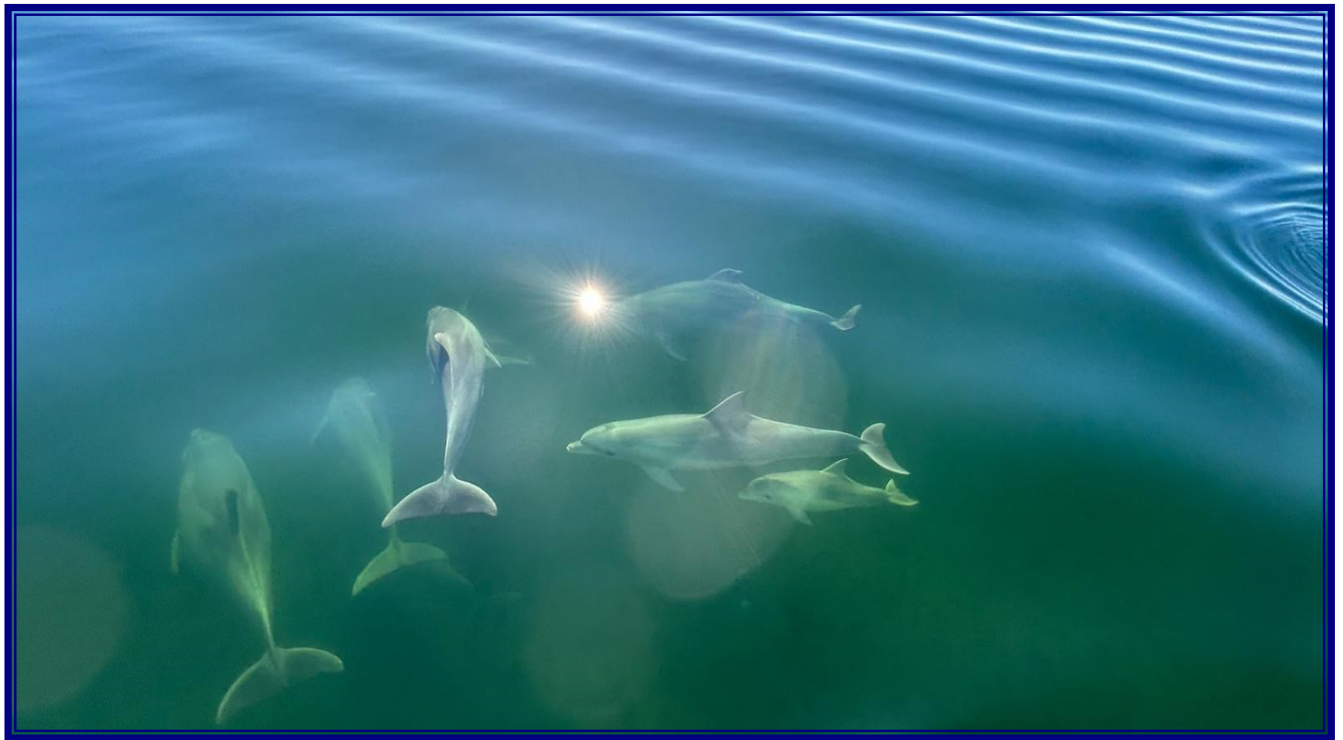

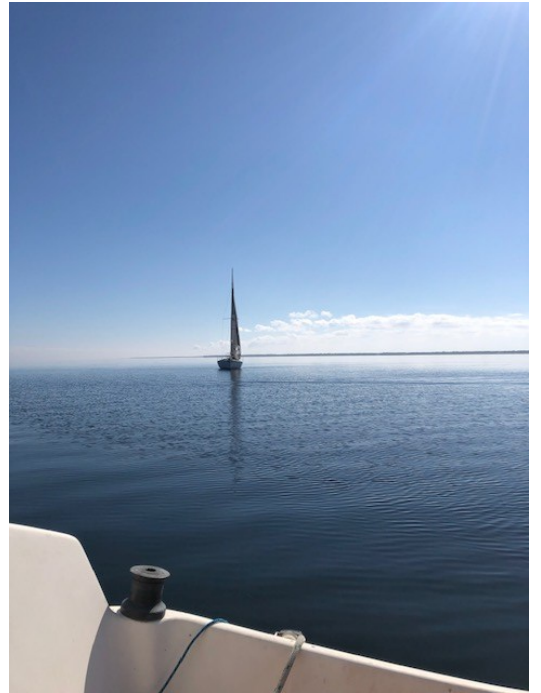


On the Waters

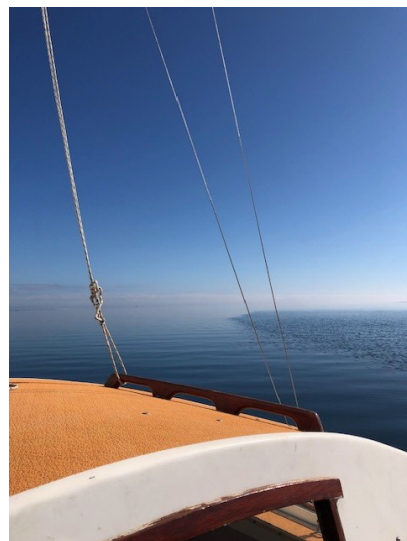
Sunday racing on 12 May; 3 keen boats looking for some wind. Thanks to Alana for the photos.

Sunday 26 May saw a spectacular encounter between Shilo and a pod of about 9 dolphins 1 km north of the St Kilda channel in the Barker Inlet. Glassy water made these terrific pictures possible (thanks to Jo and Sarah Hill). In the photo on the front page the dolphin nearest the top is "Big Fold"; he has a damaged dorsal fin and has been known to dolphin expert Mike Bossley for 20 years.



Reminder: Boats (all craft including kayaks and SUPs) are not permitted to approach marine mammals; however, as in this case, it is OK if **they** approach you. Motor in neutral is a good idea. This friendly pod played around the boat for about 2 minutes.
